

All Sierra Madre Dog Owners

As of July 1, 2012 the Pasadena Humane Society & SPCA will be handling dog licensing for your city.

According to California State law, all dogs 4 months and older must be licensed and be vaccinated against rabies. The Pasadena Humane Society & SPCA is delighted to provide licensing services for the dog owners of Sierra Madre. You may obtain your dog license at any time, but licenses must be renewed each year, even though the tags are permanent.

There are three ways you may apply for a license:

- 1. In person at Pasadena Humane Society & SPCA
- 2. At your City Hall; 232 W. Sierra Madre Blvd. Sierra Madre, Ca. 91024
- 3. By mail: Pasadena Humane Society & SPCA Attn: License Department 361 S. Raymond Ave. Pasadena, Ca. 91105

To apply for a license, please follow the instructions below:

- Complete the application available at City Hall or online at http://www.pasadenahumane.org/site/PageServer?pagename=services_licensing
- 2. Payment in the amount of \$20.00 (altered dogs), \$10.00 (altered dogs senior rate), \$40.00 (unaltered dogs) or \$20.00 (unaltered dogs senior rate)
- 3. Proof of your age if applying for a senior rate
- 4. Your pet's current rabies certificate.
- 5. Your pet's spay/neuter certificate (if applicable).
