Having an on site program would likely get a lot more involvement, like the other schools in PUSD. Please consider this when evaluating the after school program. - Beyond that these programs need to have trained and attentive staff (which was not my experience with the Y during the brief time my children were enrolled after school in Sierra Madre), the hours of the program have to match school hours and people's work schedules. The options you gave don't even match with the times the Sierra Madre schools get out. My middle school kids need care beginning at 2:30 and going until at least 6:30 or 7. If I leave work in downtown LA at 5, being here by 6 can be a real challenge. Kid care that ended at 3 on early release days would be a complete waste since I might as well just stay home verses leave work at 1:30 to pick them up at 3. Three hours a day doesn't work for everyone. If there are state guidelines (as suggested in one of the statements above) then combining the YAC with the Y may not be our best option. We may go with the YAC this year simply because the 7 pm close gives me the ability to stay at work until we close and then not worry about whether or not I am going to hit bad traffic on the way home. 8/5/11 12:19AM
