

## SIERRA MADRE POLICE BLOTTER

During the week of Sunday, December 4<sup>th</sup>, to Saturday December 10<sup>th</sup>, 2011, the Sierra Madre Police Department responded to approximately 269 calls for service. See [crimereports.com](http://crimereports.com) for updated information.

### Sunday, December 4<sup>th</sup>:

**1:29 AM- Unlawful Display Evidence of Registration, 100 blk. Esperanza Ave.** An officer stopped a 40-year old Sierra Madre motorist for a Vehicle Code violation. Further investigation revealed that the driver had false registration tabs on the vehicle. The driver was cited and released on the scene.
