POLICE BLOTTER REPORT
April 8-14, 2013

Wednesday April 10, 2013

At 2:30pm, officers responded to a business in the 300 block of West Sierra Madre Boulevard to investigate a report of a Battery. An employee allegedly grabbed the arm of a co-worker and pulled her toward another area of the business. The victim broke free from the grasp and reported the incident to her supervisors. The victim initiated a private person's arrest for the incident and the other employee was booked on the charge of battery.

Thursday April 11, 2013

Between 7-9pm, an unknown vehicle collided with a parked vehicle in the 1900 block of Oakwood Avenue. The unknown vehicle left the scene without making an attempt to contact the owner of the parked vehicle. The parked vehicle sustained moderate damage to the left rear side panel.

Friday April 12, 2013

A resident in the 700 block Fairview Avenue reported that someone had entered two of their vehicles that were parked in the driveway overnight. An unknown suspect entered the unlocked vehicles, rummaged through the interiors and removed property. A similar crime occurred a week prior in the 200 block of Grove Avenue.

Saturday April 13, 2013

At 4:30am, three individuals became involved in an argument inside an apartment in the 00 block of Esperanza. At one point, two of the individuals locked the third party out of the residence as he had become belligerent. That individual broke the living room window with a chair and tried to climb in. He failed at this and subsequently kicked the front door open. Once inside he punched one of the occupants several times in the face. When police arrived, the aggressor was arrested for Battery and Vandalism. The victim of the Battery sustained minor injuries.
