## Monday July 8, 2013

Over a period of more than 24 hours, a resident received 53 text and voice mail messages from a former friend. The individuals had a five year relationship before breaking up. The officers interviewed both parties and completed an Annoying Phone Call Report.

#### Wednesday July 10, 2013

At approximately 9pm, a resident (victim) was approached by an acquaintance (suspect) as he sat on a bench in front of 65 North Baldwin Avenue. The suspect was immediately confrontational demanding that the victim stand up and face him. When the victim stood, the suspect pushed him back onto the bench and then wrapped his arm around the victim's neck. The suspect released his hold after a few moments but continued shouting at the victim. Three individuals, who were with the suspect when the incident began, then walked him away from the location.
