**Theft from a vehicle**

A vehicle was stopped for a vehicle code violation on 5/27/19 at about 11:03PM, in the area of Baldwin Ave. and Orange Grove Ave. The driver and two passengers were found to be in possession of stolen property taken from a Sierra Madre resident's truck a few hours earlier. The owner was located and responded to the traffic stop to identify his property. The female passenger was on probation and the male passenger had a warrant out for his arrest. All three were arrested for theft and taken to the Pasadena Police jail.

**Attempted Home Burglary**

Officers responded to a possible burglary in progress at 2:11PM in the 200 block of E. Orange Grove Ave. on Tuesday, 5/28/19. Upon arrival, officers discovered a cracked, but intact, patio window. All doors and windows were secured and it did not appear that the subjects successfully entered the residence. Officers at the scene were then contacted by Arcadia PD with information that several suspects were detained from an attempted burglary close by in their city.
