

**DIRECTOR OF EMERGENCY SERVICES
EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2020-08**

WHEREAS, the Bobcat Wildfire began on September 6, 2020, and burned over 115,000 acres in the Angeles National Forest;

WHEREAS, on September 13, 2020, the Director of Emergency Services proclaimed a local emergency, which was ratified by City Council Resolution No. 20-63 and continued via Resolution No. 20-65;

WHEREAS, Sierra Madre Municipal Code Section 2.32.050 designates the City Manager as the City's Director of Emergency Services and vests the office with the authorities enumerated in Sierra Madre Municipal Code Section 2.32.060;

WHEREAS, in Resolution Nos. 20-63 & 20-65, the City Council authorized the City Manager to take any measures necessary to protect and preserve public health and safety.

THEREFORE, I, Gabriel Engeland, City Manager of the City of Sierra Madre, as Director of Emergency Services, in accordance with the authority vested in me by Government Code Section 8634, Sierra Madre Municipal Code Section 2.32.060, and City Council Resolution Nos. 20-63 & 20-65, do hereby issue the following order to become effective immediately.

SECTION 1. Opening of Sierra Madre Trails. Bailey Canyon Trail and Mount Wilson Trail will open for recreation on October 31, 2020 at 8:00 a.m.


SECTION 2. Closure of Angeles National Forest. The Angeles National Forest remains closed under the attached Forest Order No. 05-01-20-08. The City will post or install markings noting the border of the Angeles National Forest and prohibiting access.

SECTION 3. Duration. This Order rescinds Executive Order No. 2020-07 and will remain in effect until rescinded by a subsequent order or upon termination of the local emergency by the City Council.

SECTION 4. Punishment. Violation of this Order is punishable as a misdemeanor. Any person found crossing into the Angeles National Forest in violation of this Order will be subject to arrest and a fine of up to \$1,000 or imprisonment of up to six months.

SECTION 5. Filing & Posting. This Order shall be filed in the office of the City Clerk and posted on the City's website and at City Hall, the Sierra Madre Public Library, and the entrance to all trailheads leading to the Angeles National Forest.
