Motion: Commissioner Hutt moved to approve Planning Commission resolution 16-12, approving Conditional Use Permit 16-02, with deleted conditions that employees park in public parking, patrons leave keys with staff, and added conditions requiring signage inside the office alerting patients/customer that parking in Happy's parking lot is prohibited, planting of drought tolerant plants in window boxes along façade and requirement that employees park behind the building. Commissioner Desai seconded. Motion carried unanimously.
